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## Discussion Boards: Examples

Title	Description
Practice Discussion Board	Use this area to practice posting and replying to messages
Week 1: e-tivity 1 <b>Getting to know each other</b>	Say something about yourself to the rest of the group - what profession are you training for? where are you in training? what IPE have you done already and what did you get out of it? Post at least one reply to another member of the group.
Week 2: e-tivity 1 <b>Introducing John and Monica</b>	What are your initial thoughts about what Monica has said? How do you feel about this situation? Do you know anybody who has had a similar experience to Monica?
Week 3: e-tivity 1 <b>Chocolate or Clinifeed?</b>	List the people that you think were involved in the care of John's PEG in the hospital environment. Then consider how this might change when John is discharged.  Come back to the forum after reflection and respond to the points of others to explore how things have changed in the community and who carries the main responsibility for the care and use of the PEG
Week 3: e-tivity 2 <b>Gadgets and gizmos</b>	Once you feel the wiki reflects a thorough range of views, consider the reality of the situation and how it impact on John and Monica. For example, how might rooms in their home look, or how many visitors will be calling on them to deliver, give instructions or maintain the equipment ? Post ideas here.
Week 3: e-tivity 3 <b>Consenting Adults</b>	Consider which professional issues the video highlights and share these on the discussion forum.  Post your thoughts on the issue of informed consent in a new thread.



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Week 3: e-tivity 3 <b>Consenting Adults</b>	This discussion will identify the issues highlighted by the 'angry' video clip.
Week 4: e-tivity 1 <b>A carer is not part of the team??</b>	Drawing on your own experience post a short paragraph on a <b>positive</b> and <b>negative</b> example to highlight the advantages and disadvantages for a team working with family/carers
Week 4: e-tivity 2 <b>Carers managing teams</b>	As future health and social care professionals <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• What problems do you envisage for your profession and the team and how should we be preparing to address them?</li><li>• Do you support the concept of carers as team leaders? Why and why not?</li></ul> Post a paragraph of your thoughts in reaction to these questions to generate debate and discussion.
Week 5: e-tivity 1 <b>How you have learnt from others</b>	Post one paragraph (approximately 200 words) on how a contribution from another health professional on this event has enlightened your understanding of inter-professional care.
Week 5: e-tivity 2 <b>Forward Into Practice</b>	Post an additional paragraph (approximately 200 words) on how you will take forward in practice what you have learnt to ensure that patient/service user and carers are central to future health and social care.



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
