STRAND ONE Group ice-breaker – eggs can fly!

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Inter-Professional Learning – Group ice-breaker - Eggs can fly!

One member of group to collect kit containing:

- 1 fresh egg
- 2 sheets of paper
- 1 roll of tape (you must not use more than 60 cm)
- 2 balloons
- 1 length of string
- 1 pair of scissors
- 6 wrapped sweets

You now have ten minutes to complete this task. At the end of ten minutes one member of your team will drop the egg to the ground from a given height onto a designated area. The egg must fall free and land intact and unbroken.

You may not change the composition of the egg in any way. You must use all the materials provided (and only those materials) to enhance your success.

The facilitator and each group will select a criteria for judging the success of this task.

At the end of the task you must reflect on this exercise and complete session one in your workbook.
