STRAND ONE Group discussion activity – Scenario One

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Inter-Professional Learning - Scenario One

Rosie, a 28-year-old married woman, is confined to a wheelchair following a horse riding accident, damaging her lower spine and pelvis.

Having been informed that pregnancy was unlikely following her pelvic trauma, Rosie visited her health centre with a history of nausea and vomiting and general tiredness.

PLEASE TO COMPLETE THE FOLLOWING TASKS

Task One: Consider the following five questions, since you will have to demonstrate an understanding of these to your facilitator in the final session.

- A) What are the needs of this person and her carers?
- B) What are the people who might be involved in meeting this person and her carers needs (list all people/agencies)?
- C) Outline their different roles and consider different professional values.
- D) How might interprofessional working benefit and/or disadvantage this person and her carers?

Task Two: Design and create an information leaflet that you could give to this person and her carers. This leaflet should introduce the team and should give information on the services they provide to meet their needs. The leaflet will be on one piece of A4 paper, you need to give a copy and describe your leaflet to your facilitator and your other group members at the final session.

Reflect on the benefits and challenges of working together as an interprofessional group on this task.
